

share and never blame.





That's the way I'd rather be



and chips whilst others like eating curry.





## Diversity

If you're yellow, black, white or brown, we're all friends, no need to frown.


If you eat pizza, or chips, or even dips or all other delicious things. We all eat differently, because that's, our thing.
