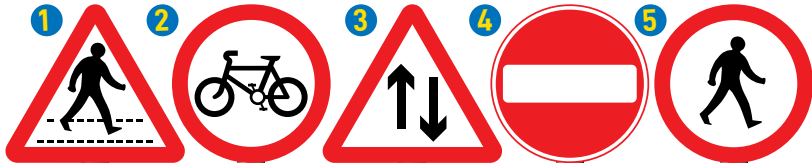

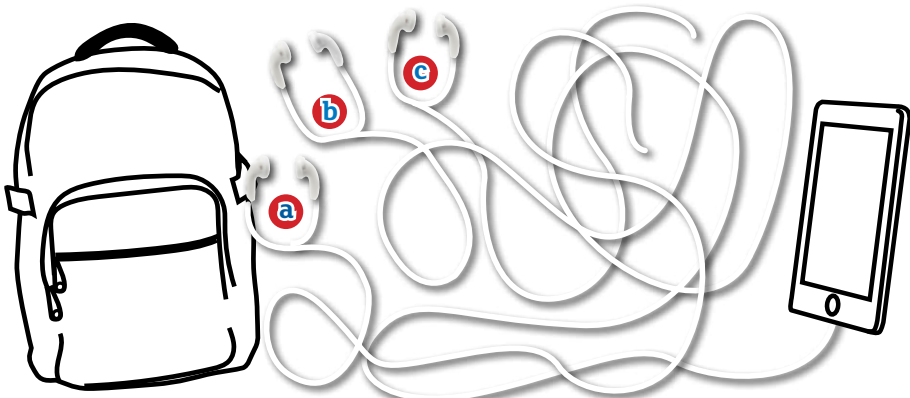
EYE EYE!
