At Welton Primary School, we fully recognise our responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of all of our pupils. We believe that not only is this a moral and statutory responsibility but we know that children who feel safe and secure at school are more likely to achieve their full potential.

We want to work in partnership with you, and discuss any concerns we may have or that you may have.

It is our intention to inform and involve you at every stage in your child's time at the school.

Since the first priority is your child's welfare, there may be rare occasions when our concern about your child means that we have to consult other agencies even before we contact you.

The East Riding Safeguarding Children Board has laid down the procedures we follow, and the school has adopted a Safeguarding Policy in line with this for the safety of all.
