

PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

The Children Act 1989 acknowledges the fact that parents do not always live at the same address as their children.

The Act says that it is best for children if they are brought up by their family. 'Family' includes the people the child lives with as well as people with parental responsibility who live elsewhere.

The following people have parental responsibility:-

Married Parents Automatically Mothers of non marital children Automatically

Fathers of non marital children By court order on his application

By formal agreement with mother By being appointed quardian

Guardian By court order

Adoptive Parents

By appointment in writing or will
Automatically with adoption

Parents of children in care Share parental responsibility with

local authority

Other person with whom the

child lives By court order

Divorce or separation does **not** affect parental responsibility unless the court makes an order. The court will **not** make an order unless it is better for the child to do so than not to do so.

Parental responsibility can only be **lost** by court order or adoption.

All people with parental responsibility must be treated equally. This means that they are all entitled to reports, invitations to parents' meetings etc. Schools must, therefore, keep up to date records of all people with parental responsibility, as well as any court orders relating to the child (ie old custody orders or Children Act 1989 orders).
