Dear Parents,

Please note the following changes or reminders in regards to school rules for September 2015:

- The only bags permitted will be a book bag and PE bag (shoe bag or school PE bag).



Pupils bringing other bags to school will be asked to leave them at home.

- All pupils in Years 1 to 6 require the following indoor and outdoor PE kit:
 - i. school PE t-shirt
 - ii. black or blue PE shorts
 - iii. trainers or plimsolls
 - iv. black or blue tracksuit bottoms
 - v. plastic studded football boots or astro' boots
 - vi. optional school hoodie (pupils may wear their school sweatshirt or school fleece for PE)

Pupils without the correct PE kit will be given school PE kit to wear. If forgetting kit is a regular occurrence teachers will follow this up with parents. As the school continues to employ specialist sports coaches it is essential all pupils have the specified kit as above. Please find an order form overleaf for hoodies/bags.

- Please ensure children are wearing the correct **named** school uniform:
 - i. Royal blue sweatshirt jumper or cardigan
 - ii. Blue or yellow polo shirt
 - iii. Grey or black tunic, skirt, shorts or trousers
- After careful consideration at a Governors Meeting, the school will be enforcing rigorously its existing jewellery policy. Pupils will be asked to remove earrings before break and PE sessions; if they are unable to put them back in themselves they will be returned to parents via the school office.
- Pupils should not bring any toys or other items from home into school (valuable or otherwise). If the teacher is requesting artefacts for a topic they will request this via a letter. Exception to the rule: a medal, certificate or cup for a sporting or other major achievement.
- Mobile phones are only permitted if the child hands it into the school office on arrival.
- Any child bringing a pen knife or similar item to school will be subject to an immediate fixed term exclusion. No exceptions.

Thank you for support in all of the above. We strive to maintain the highest possible standards and expectations for our pupils in all things and following the school rules is a very important feature of this.
