Dear Welton Family,

In response to requests from parents, we have risk assessed the impact of making changes to the staggered start and finish times without causing unnecessary disruption. We have evaluated this very carefully as it seems there is a long way to go before our community is safe from the risk of transmission and further class and bubble closures. However, with the support of the entire school community in following some simple rules and systems we will trial reviewed timings. If we can work together successfully, we will continue with these new arrangements but should we not be able to engage the whole school community with this, it will be necessary to return to the previous arrangements. The key to success:

- Arrive as close to the designated time as possible
- Ensure your child lines up in the designated place
- Wait at the opposite side of the road to the school entrances if you are early
- Ensure children who walk to school alone don't arrive early
- Socially distance from other parents
- Consider the positive impact of wearing a mask around the school entrances even if you do not enter the site

Please see the attached documents which inform you of the revised start and finish times and very importantly the entrances and exits and lining up points.
