need? Shelter

These are usually tents or plastic tarpaulins to protect refugees from the elements and provide security and privacy.

Emergency Relief Items

Families often flee with just a few belongings. They will need essential supplies such as blankets, sleeping mats, mosquito nets, clothing and other personal care kits.

Water and Sanitation

They will need clean water and a waste management system to meet their basic needs.

Food

Refugees will need food and kitchen items to enable them to feed themselves.

Healthcare


This includes access to medical care, immunization programs and mental health support.

Legal support

Refugees will need help and support to ensure they have the correct documentation to enable them to stay together.



Refugees flee their home countries because they fear persecution based on their race, social group, religion, or political views. Additionally, some people leave their countries to escape civil war and natural disasters. Some countries are both a haven for refugees and a country refugees escape from.
