Vocabulary:

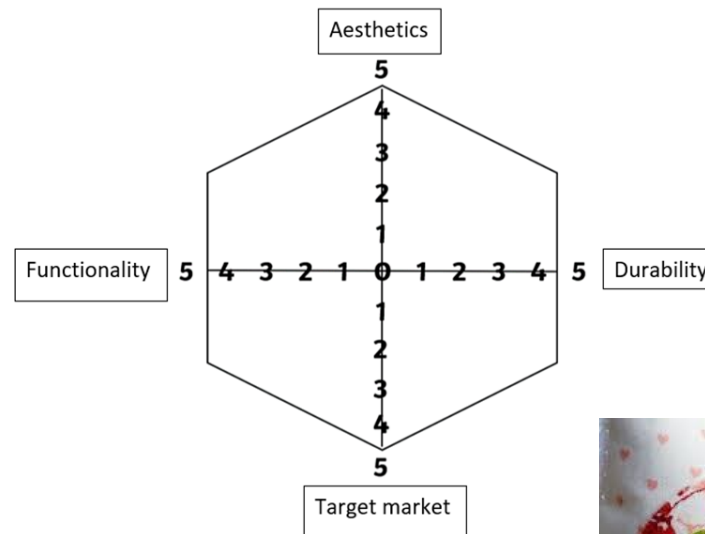
Aesthetics	Related to how something looks—usually in a positive light.
Running stitch	Hand stitch for seams and gathering.
Back stitch	A method of sewing with overlapping stitches
Applique	Decorate with pieces of fabric to form pictures or patterns.
Embroidery	Form decorative designs with hand or machine needlework
Annotated sketch	A combination of notes and labelled drawings that provide an explanation.
Durability	The ability to withstand wear, pressure, or damage.
Functionality	The quality of being suited to serve a purpose well.
Target Market	A particular group which a product or service is aimed at.
Design decisions	Making choices throughout the process based on the design brief, resources and skills available.
Quilt	Join fabric with lines of stitching to form a warm bed covering, gar-

Design Brief:

A **Traditional Quilt** is one that uses regularly repeating shapes based on a grid. The blocks used can be simple or complex, or familiar historical blocks where the rows and columns are the same block.

You will be given a piece of fabric and are challenged with using applique and embroidery skills which will be used to create a class blanket. Your design must best represent yourself and focus on the skills taught—the finished blanket will be donated to the local community.
