Aesthetics	Related to how something looks—usually in a positive light.

# **Design Brief:**

There has been a lighthouse at Spurn point since as early as the 15th century. The current lighthouse was built in 1895 to replace a pair of lighthouses (one of these remains as a water tower). It was decommissioned in 1985 as navigation improved, and remained empty for decades. The lighthouse was restored in 2013.

Yorkshire Wildlife Trust have given you funding to redesign the lighthouse at Spurn point. They are looking for detailed cross-sectional designs and models to accompany the designs. They have also asked for an electrical component to be used as part of the internal mechanisms.
