Artefacts	An object made by a human being, typically one of cultural or historical interest
Bullying	To cause (someone) to do something by means of force.
Celebration	To celebrate an important day or event
Colour	Pigmentation of the skin, especially as an indication of someone's ethnicity
Conflict	A disagreement or argument,
Culture	The ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society
Cyber Bullying	Bullying that is done by posting hurtful electronic messages on the internet.
Difference	Being different from or not like.
Direct	To aim what one says or writes towards a particular person or group
Discrimination	The act of treating some people unfairly because of prejudice.
Developing World	A poor agricultural country that is seeking to become more advanced economically and socially.
Happiness	An emotional state characterized by feelings of joy, satisfaction, contentment, and fulfilment.
Homophobic	An extreme fear or hatred of homosexuals or homosexuality.

Name Calling	Offensive, abusive language, or insults.
Race	A human population sharing common physical characteristics that have been passed down from one generation to the next.
Racism	Unfair treatment of people based on the opinion that one race is better than another.
Rumour	a piece of information passed from one person to another without any proof that it is true
Texting	Sending a short message typed on a cell phone and sent to another cell phone
