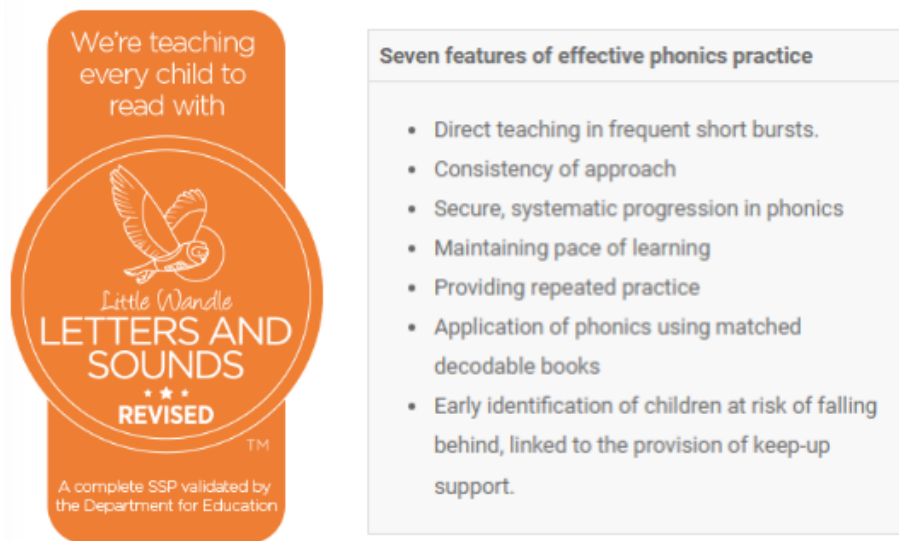


Phonics at Welton

At Welton Primary School we aim to provide a reading curriculum that allows our children to read with metacognition, develop a love of reading, including reading for pleasure, across a range of diverse authors that challenge stereotypes and raise aspirations. We believe that reading is an essential life skill which will unlock life-long learning, academic success, positive wellbeing and enjoyment for our children.

We teach our children to read through the use of phonics. At Welton we follow the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised scheme.
