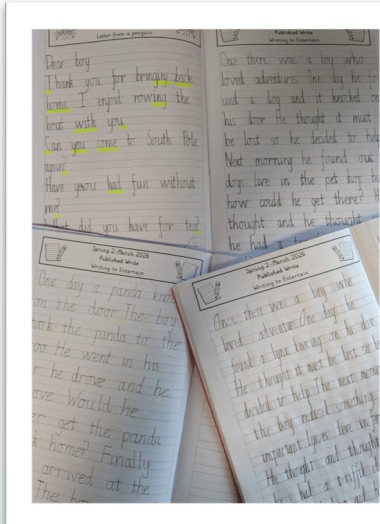

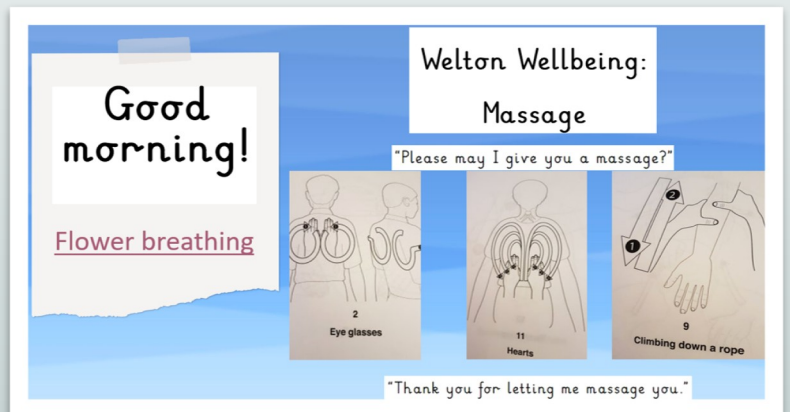
Stay and Learn



This academic year we have extended our stay and read to include other subjects from the school day. This term we have covered handwriting and Welton wellbeing.

The research behind the importance of automaticity with handwriting is well documented and fits with the focus we have had at Welton for many years. Parents were able to see a lesson being taught and join in to test their skills! Staff and children modelled correct pencil grip, warm up lines and how to form letters, starting in the correct place.

This half term the children invited parents to join them in a Welton wellbeing session. The children take part in a 10-15 minute session daily which covers a range of skills that the children can learn as part of their wellbeing toolkit. Parents were encouraged to join in with a massage session - helping to develop positive touch, breathing techniques, proprioception and a visualisation. The children have learnt about the brain theory behind the activities they demonstrated and could explain why being calm is essential to good learning. Hopefully, those who took part, set off to work with a calm and positive attitude after attending!

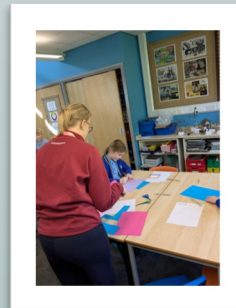
