<u>Teaching Assistants identified the following strengths at Welton</u> School:

- Children have choices and most understand the consequences of wrong choices.
- Children are clear about rules.
- Children are free to express themselves but on occasions need to be guided towards *appropriate* expression. Staff guide them so that they understand things from another point of view.
- Children have opportunities to celebrate their uniqueness but some do not want attention drawn to them.

Ideas for future development of the promotion of British Values:

- Build into Creative Contexts. Looking at recorders, dancing, textiles, music and traditions from around the world to tolerate and embrace Britain and contrasting places and cultures.
- Capturing memorable moments that celebrate diversity, rules and choices on the British Values display board.
