


PARENT SURVEY 2015

Thank you to all parents who completed our parental survey this year. There were 164 responses received from 270 families, equating to 61%. Anything over 30% is relevant in terms of analysis. We have analysed the results and the comments made from parents and would like to share these with you.

HOMEWORK

There were varying views on homework depending on the ages of the children. Foundation parents



thought that the children were being given too much homework. We listened to this feedback and guidance is now given as to whether the homework is a priority or optional. For those parents of older children we have now subscribed to the online programme called MyMaths and also encourage children to use the online Bug Club to supplement the homework provided by the class teachers.

Consideration has also been given to the communication of additional lessons for children after school.



Below: The school seeks the views of parents and takes account of their suggestions and concerns.




FROM OUR SURVEY ...

Having analysed the results of the survey, we feel that the next steps are to:-



1. Consider the use of online payments for school meals, trips, Out of School Club etc.
