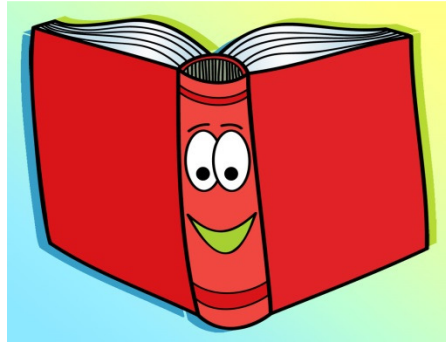
Children will have the opportunity to read their new purchase in an outdoor reading session in school and then take home to read to you at home.
