Top of the Class

In January 2017 we were featured in the Yorkshire Post as one of the schools identified as the highest achieving schools in Yorkshire 2016

The number of pupils achieving the expected standard in reading mathematics and writing ensures we are highest attaining school in the South Hunsley Partnership of schools and 18th out of 139 schools in the local authority.

Progress and attainment at Welton is in the top 15% of all schools nationally in Maths, Reading and Writing and an impressive top 8% nationally for progress in writing.



In June 2016 we had a very successful OFSTED which identified we had maintained our Outstanding features in:

- Pupils feeling safe and secure
