Dodgeball is the first experience that our Year 3 children have had at external competition within the South Hunsley Partnership scheme.

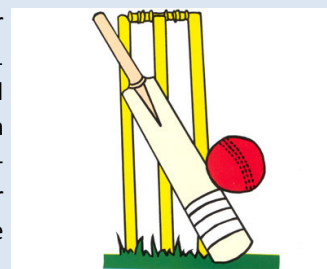
